

## **The Earthly Moment of Grace- *Tetelesthai***

Dagg: The Son of God gave his life to redeem those who were given to him by the Father in the covenant of Grace.

### I. The Moment of Procurement

- A. John 19:28, 30 “All things were now accomplished,” vinegar, “It is finished.”
- B. Luke 23:45 –“The veil of the Temple was rent in the midst”
- C. Mt. 27:46 Mk 15:34 – At the ninth hour, Jesus cried with a loud voice, “My God, My God, to what end have you abandoned me?”

### II. For whom did Christ come to give his Life?

- A. Some verses point to Particular People – Matthew 1:21; Mark 10:45; John 10:11, 14-15, 26; Ephesians 5:25-27; Hebrews 9:15;10: 9, 10, 14; Romans 8:32ff; Isaiah 53: 4-6, 8, 10,11
- B. Some verses use Universal language – John 3:16; Romans 5:18; 2 Corinthians 5:14, 15; 1 John 2:2; 1 Timothy 2:3-6
  - 1. Rather than condemning the whole world, God is saving the world
  - 2. Messiahship not just Jewish nation, people throughout the world.
  - 3. The extent of “all” is defined by the sphere of its application

### III. What is the Nature of the Death of Christ?

- A. It is the Source of all other blessings as a meritorious cause - Ephesians 1:3; Hebrews 13:20, 21
- B. In summary form it consists of Reconciliation – 2 Corinthians 5:14, 18
  - 1. Substitution – Romans 5:6-8; 2 Corinthians 5:21; 1 Peter 2:21-24; 3:18
  - 2. Propitiation – Luke 18:13, Hebrews 2:17 Romans 3:24-26 ;Hebrews 9:5; 1 John 2:2, 4:10.

### IV. What are the results of the Death of Christ?

- A. Forgiveness – Revelation 1:5 Ephesians 1:7; 1 John 1:7-9; Colossians 2:13
- B. Justification – Romans 3:24; Romans 5: 9-10
- C. All the gifts of the Spirit – Colossians 2:10-15
  - 1. Regeneration
  - 2. Adoption – Galatians 4
  - 3. Sanctification
- D. Disarms Satan – Hebrews 2:14, 15; Colossians 2:15
